

Make Ten Again?

For: Younger Primary Children with variations for older.

This is a great activity to practice addition and subtraction in a fun way. Extensions for multiplication and division.



- Cards or paper cut to size (postits will do)
- Scissors
- Markers




Instructions

- 1. Cut out 12 cards
- 2. Number the cards 1-10 in big writing
- 3. Write the symbols + and = on the last two cards
- 4. Lay out all the cards on the table
- 5. The challenge is to make up the value 10 using various cards
- 6. You can do this by picking a number and asking the child to find the number that will make up 10 with the chosen number.
- 7. Lay out the cards into a proper sum i.e. 1+9 = 10







Extensions

- How many ways can the players make up 10?
- Make another card with minus sign to practice subtraction also.
- If you make up more + and cards can the players find more ways to make 10?
- For older or more able players you can add in × and
 ÷.
- If the players want another extra challenge, you could make different Target numbers.
- If the players find all this too easy they may be ready to play TargetBoards Or our 24 Game
