


- Arrange 8 matchsticks to form the grid below.
- Now, move only 2 matchsticks to create exactly 2 equal-size squares.
















HAVE A GO!

HINT: The two squares do NOT have to be the same size.














- Arrange 6 matchsticks to form the triangle shown below.
- Now, move only 2 matchsticks to create exactly 2 equal-size triangles.
















HAVE A GO!

HINT: The two squares do NOT have to be the same size.














- Arrange 8 matchsticks to form the fish.
- A- Move 3 matchsticks so the fish swim to the left.
- B- **Move** 2 matchsticks so the fish is swimming upwards.















- Arrange 10 matchsticks to form the house below.
- By moving 2 matchesticks view this house from a different angle.
















- Arrange 9 matchsticks to form the shape below.
- Move 3 matchsticks to make it looks like a box.
















- Arrange 12 matchsticks to form the shape shown below.
- Now, by moving 4 matchsticks create a single cross.


















- Arrange 12 matchsticks to form the grid below.
- Now, move only 4 matchsticks to create exactly 4 equal-size squares.
















- Arrange 4 matchsticks to form the glass shown here plus a counter for the cherry.

- B-Could you do it by moving 2 matchsticks?
















- During the World Cup, Ireland played against Scotland.

- By moving 2 matchsticks avoid the try made against Ireland. The posts should be the same size and shape. Do not move the counter.
















- Arrange 16 matchsticks to form 5 squares as shown here.
