	<ol> <li>Instructions</li> <li>1. Cut out 12 cards</li> <li>2. Number the cards 1-10 in big writing</li> <li>3. Write the symbols + and = on the last two cards</li> <li>4. Lay out all the cards on the table</li> <li>5. The challenge is to make up the value 10 using various cards</li> <li>6. You can do this by picking a number and asking the child to find the number that will make up 10 with the chosen number.</li> <li>7. Lay out the cards into a proper sum i.e. 1+9 = 10</li> </ol>
