



TRIANGLE

Connect in Series





1 to 34



1. Take a plastic needle and thread the wool through it.

2. Join the numbered hole from 1 to 34 of the same colour in order.


3. Start with your needle at the back of your template and go up through the hole 1 in BLUE. Bring the thread over (not all the way, leave some length) and then down to the hole 2 in BLUE.



4. Then, on the same side, bring the thread to the hole 3 in BLUE and go up and then down to the hole 4 in BLUE. Keep going.

5. When you have finished one colour, do the same to the other 2 sides.

6. Turn over the template. Tie the 2 ends together. Try to get under the other threads to make it a bit more secure.



TIP: If you need more wool, make a simple knot to join the 2 strings together. To make it neater, cut the string to make sure your knot stays on the back of the template so it's not visible on the front.

You can use the same or different colours for each corner of the triangle.

You can use one colour for the odd and another for the even, or make up your own pattern.
