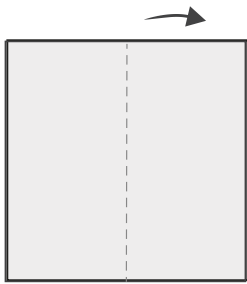


Origami Christmas Hat

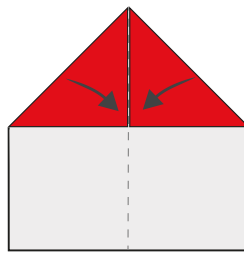


Materials Needed:

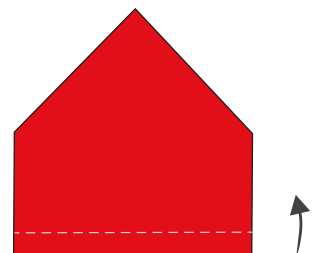
- a square piece of paper (red or green for Christmas colors)
- stickers, markers, pom pom or cotton balls for decorating (optional)



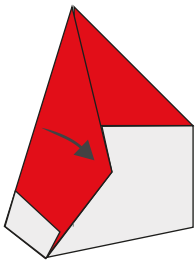
Step 1: Start with a square paper with white side up and fold it in half to make a rectangle. Unfold.



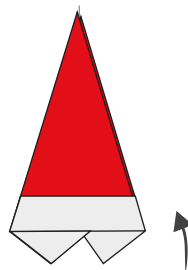
Step 2: Fold the left corner in to meet the middle crease. Repeat with the right corner.



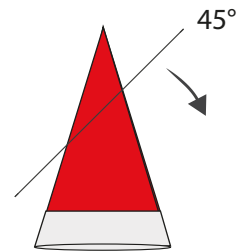
Step 3: Turnover the paper. Fold the bottom edge up about a quarter of the whole paper.



Step 4: Take the left-hand side and fold down at an angle just past the centre. Repeat the right hand -side folding to the edge of the previous fold to make a point to make a cone.



Step 5: Turnover the paper. Take the bottom points and fold them up using the bottom of the white strip as a guide. Then, tuck them underneath itself.



Step 6: Fold down the top of the hat at a 45 degrees angle and press flat. Stick on a mini pom pom to the end of the hat.

Tips: *You may need a little glue or double-sided to secure the hat.
*Use stickers, markers, or cotton balls to decorate.
*Learn how to make a square from A4 paper.
*Try different thicknesses, textures and types of paper, such as newspaper and magazine.
